

# LOCAL SHOPPING



## MERCADO SAN AGUSTIN

5.1 MILES AWAY

The shopping center is patterned after a traditional outdoor Mexican marketplace, but this local shopping destination is 100 percent

Tucson. It features a rustic courtyard with greenery, shaded seating, and dozens of locally owned shops. The market regularly hosts special events, including live music, food festivals, arts and performance shows, and a regular farmer's market.



## 4TH AVE SHOPPING

6.1 MILES AWAY

Over 100 shops line the streets of Fourth Avenue in Tucson, including boutiques, art galleries, bookstores, sundry shops, and more.

This is your one-stop destination for funky fashion, unique decor and gift items, and that perfect souvenir from your Tucson sojourn. Along with great shopping, you'll also find plenty of dining options, including cafes, restaurants, and bars.



## DOWNTOWN TUCSON

6.1 MILES AWAY

Downtown Tucson is a hip and bustling district filled with restaurants, shops, and a wealth of museums, including the Museum of Contemporary Art Tucson and the Children's Museum Tucson. A walk along the Turquoise Trail passes historic sites like the grand 1850's Cathedral of Saint Augustine. There are also regular live performances at both the Tucson Arena and the Arizona Theater Company.

# LOCAL RESTAURANTS



## AGUSTIN KITCHEN

5.1 MILES AWAY

Located in the Mercado San Agustin shopping center and is patterned after a traditional outdoor Mexican marketplace. Agustin Kitchen is a sophisticated bistro featuring fresh dishes, a lively bar scene & a Sunday brunch menu.



## LACO TUCSON

5.8 MILES AWAY

Located in the heart of the Historic Presidio District of Downtown Tucson and tucked inside the walls of Old Town artisans, you will find the beautiful courtyard restaurant that is LaCo Tucson. Boasting al fresco dining, a rustic Cantina, the new home of Tallboys, and live music under the stars this gem certainly offers something for everyone.

5.7 MILES AWAY

# LOCAL ATTRACTIONS



## ARIZONA SONORA DESERT MUSEUM

11.5 MILES AWAY

The Desert Museum is a fusion experience: Zoo, botanical garden, art gallery & classes, natural history museum, and aquarium.



## SAGUARO NATIONAL PARK

12.6 MILES AWAY

Saguaro National Park is uniquely situated around the 500 square miles that make up Tucson, which is at the heart of the Sonoran Desert which sits just under 2,400 feet above sea level.



## SAN XAVIER DEL BAC MISSION

13.2 MILES AWAY

The Mission was created to serve the needs of the local community, the village of Wa:k (San Xavier District) on the Tohono O'odham reservation, as it still does today. We have people from all over the country, and the world, wanting to have their special event here at the Mission.



## PIMA AIR AND SPACE MUSEUM

14.5 MILES AWAY

Featuring about 400 historic aircraft, from a Wright Flyer to a 787 Dreamliner. Sitting on 80 acres the museum opened its doors to the public in May of 1976.
