In August, 1945, during the annual agricultural extension service conference, held on the University Hawaii campus, the Hawaii Home Demonstration Agents' Association was organized with the following officers elected:

President - Frances Jones, South Oahu

Secretary - Mamie Tillema, Kauai
Treasurer - Winifred Chin, Maui

News reporter & agent at large - Esther Rugland, Honolulu.

Frances Jones, president of the Hawaii home demonstration agents association, will sum up the organization's first year of work before the home agents' annual conference at the University of Hawaii today.



During the business meeting at 1 p.m. in Hemenway hall, members will discuss problems of home agent work throughout the islands.

Four islands - Miss Jones - will be represented in the executive board meetings. Those present will include Miss Jones of East Hawaii; Mrs. Sylvia Barnes, vice president from South Oahu; Mamie Tillema, secretary from Kauai; Mrs. Winifred Chine, treasurer from Maui; and Esther Rugland, news reporter and agent-at-large from Honolulu.

The constitution committee composed of Esther Opland, Lillian Tubb and Esther Rugland will outline the progress made towards forming goals for the Hawaii association.

Professional improvement recommendations will be submitted by a committee made up of Alice Hancock, Genevieve Feagin and Ruth Eyres.

The annual association dinner will be held Tuesday evening at 945 16th avenue.

The Hawaii home demonstration agents association, which was formed a year ago at the annual agricultural extension service conference, is affiliated with the national HDAA and national home economics association.
